Lycia will encourage reflections around accepting help, so your family member will have to acknowledge their condition and the physical and cognitive changes that come along with it.

It might be hard – and downright intimidating – to speak up. You might leave appointments with more questions than answers. But your role and voice are important; you are managing many aspects of your own care.
